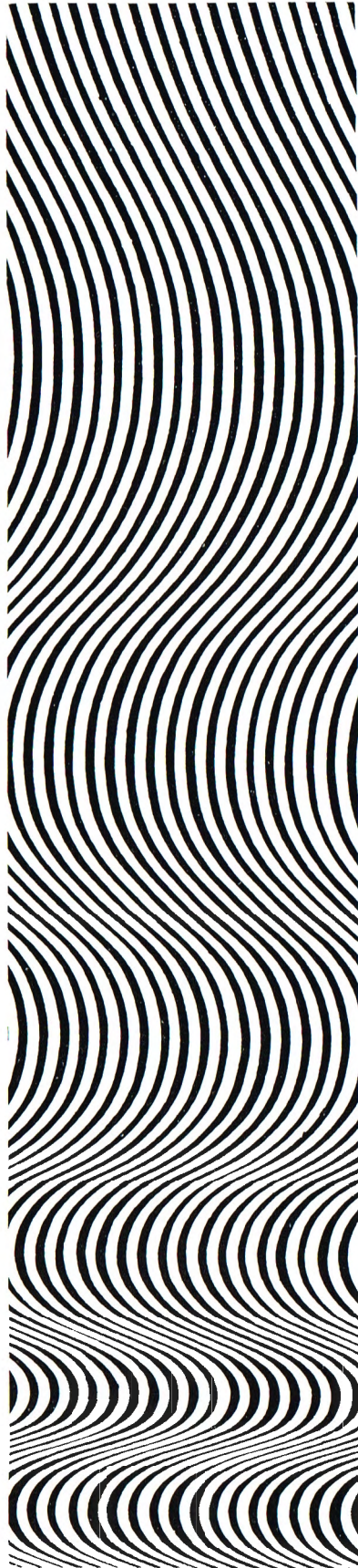

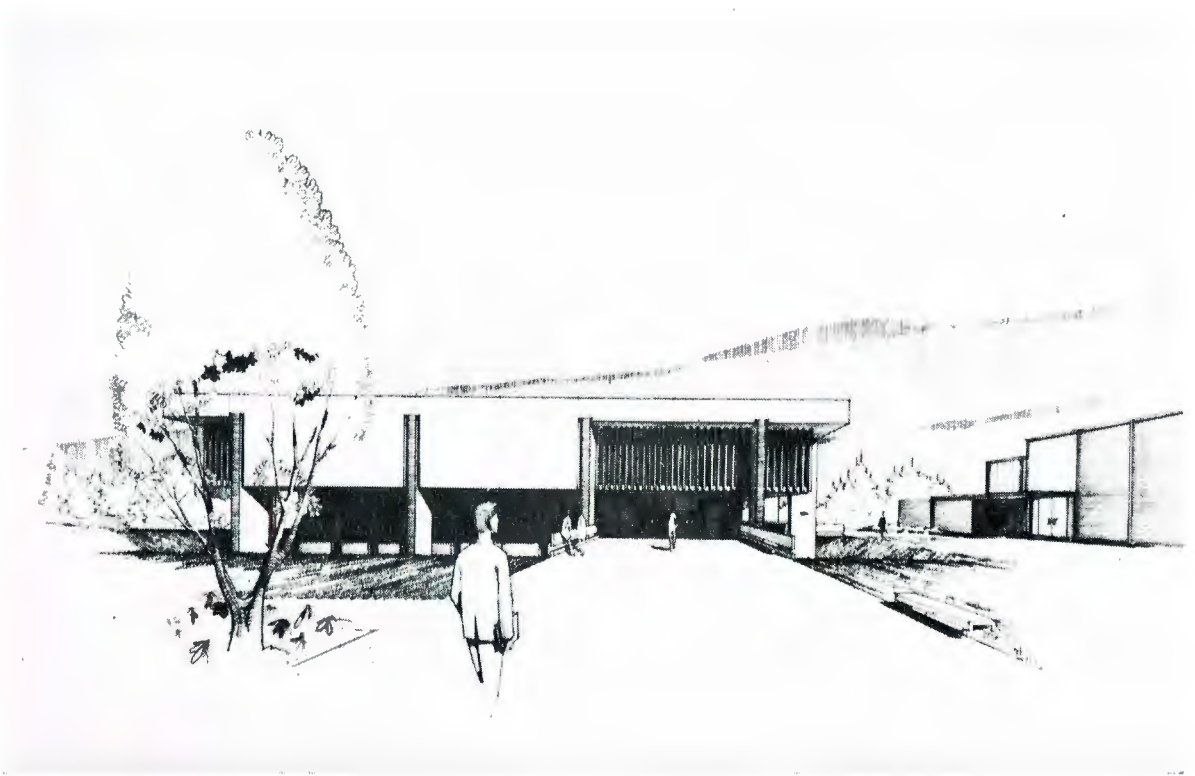
Mr. Landberg has also spent time studying Oriental philosophy and the art that comes from this philosophy. He has spent close to ten years studying the art of judo.
