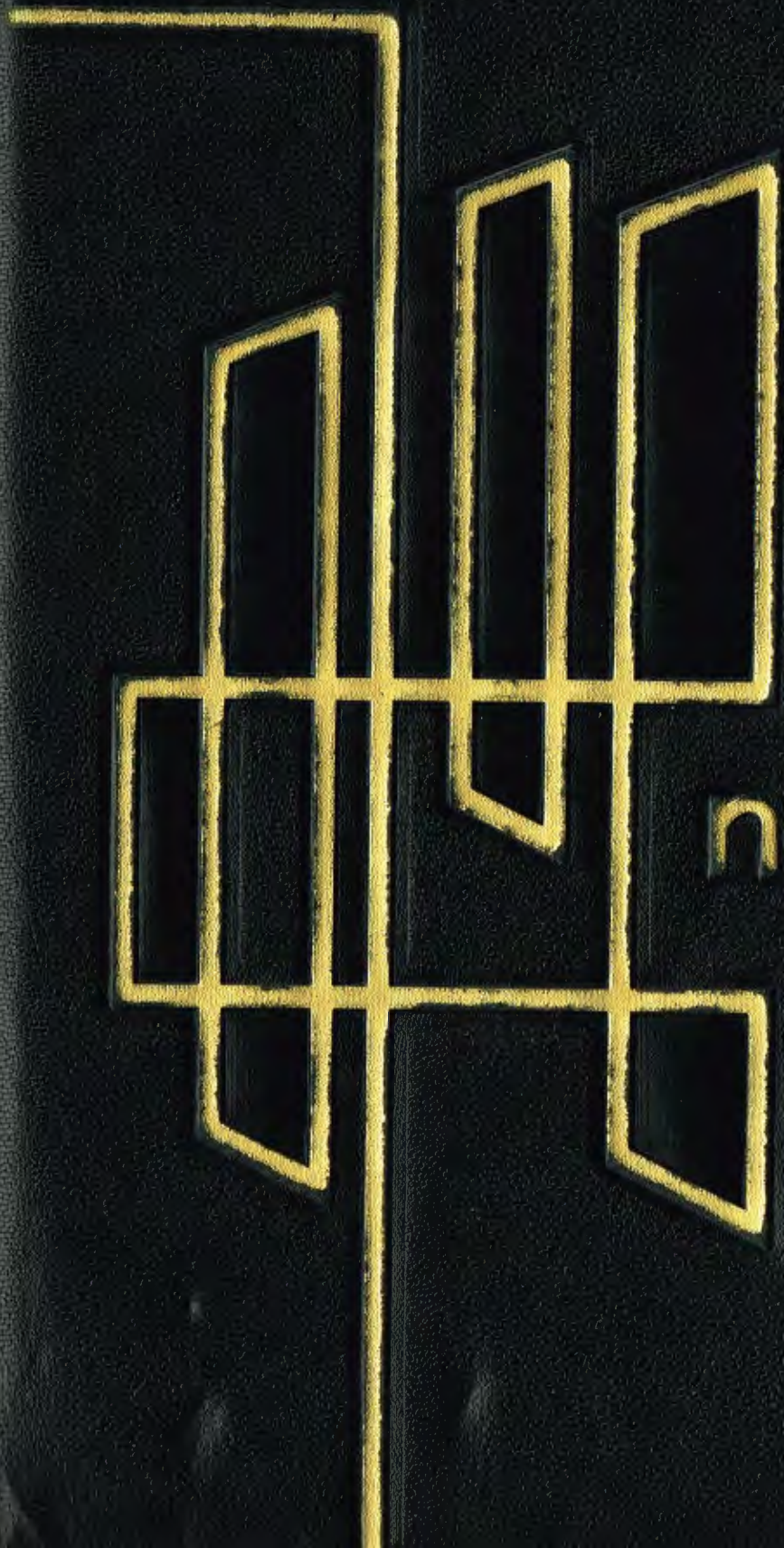

Next year should see a new library under construction; the existing library will then be remodeled into three classrooms. The present engineering room will be remodeled into a new chemistry laboratory.



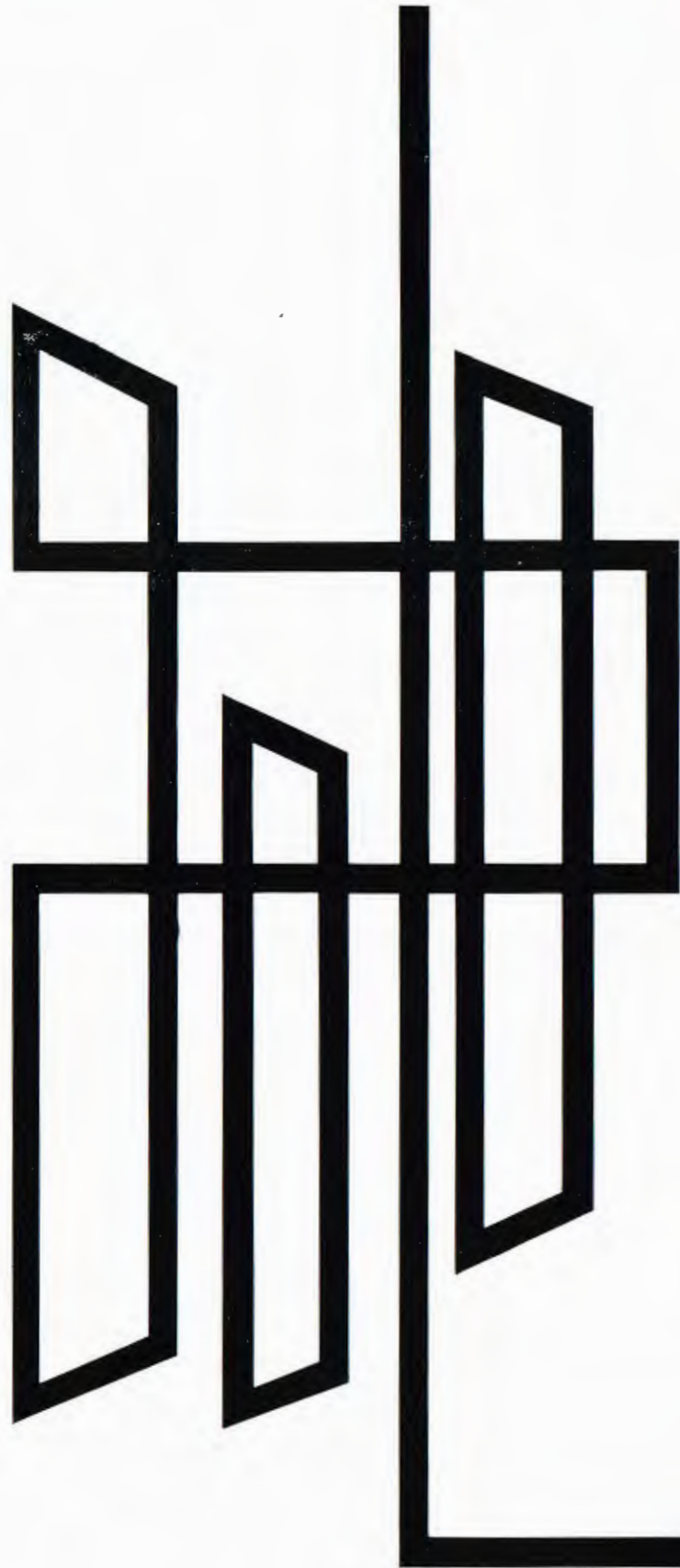
