

Washington State Stackable Certificates

Early Childhood Education Statewide Certificates

In Washington State, early learning professionals who want to further their education have a clear path to follow: stackable certificates/degrees are made up of common courses available statewide. Visit the ECE Career Planning Portal to learn more: ececareers.del.wa.gov.

Colleges across the state offer common course numbers, course titles, course descriptions and student outcomes that are consistent within the professional development system.

All courses are aligned with the *Washington State Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals* (EPS_0023) available online at www.dcyf.wa.gov/publications-library/eps_0023. They allow students to earn “stackable” certificates: the courses that students are required to take will build on one another in a sequential manner and deepen levels of applied learning along the way.
